
I have your letter dated May 15, 2006. The program to which you refer is Title IV D of the Social Security Act. Pursuant to that Act, state courts are entitled to be reimbursed for certain expenditures related to the processing, hearing and issuing of child support orders. There is a cap on the amount that can be reimbursed.

Marital Masters are appointed pursuant to the statutory authority found RSA 490-D and exercise their duties in accordance with that law.

On November 25 and December 6, 2005, you wrote to my office and on January 11, 2006, you received a response from Attorney Apicelli. In her letter to you, Attorney Apicelli gave you specific instructions as to what information was required to complete the review you requested. To date, we have not received that information.

When we receive the required information, we will continue the process of your request.

Judge Kelly forwarded to me a copy of your November 28, 2006 request for information about Marital Masters' wages and the sums the Judicial Branch was reimbursed by Health and Human Services under Title IV-D of the Social Security Act. I enclose a spreadsheet that shows wages, longevity pay, New Hampshire Retirement System contributions, Medicare contributions, life insurance payments, FICA contributions, and taxable mileage reimbursements for 15 Marital Masters from calendar year 2003 through calendar year 2006. This schedule also shows the amount billed to the United States Department of Health and Human Services during the fiscal year, in connection with services rendered by each Marital Master. Please note that I have not included information about health and dental insurance payments or about health equipment reimbursements made on behalf of Marital Masters.
